

Competitions for 2016 season

Sat 9th April 1st Tarsan Comp Eight members attended the weigh in at 6pm

The top rod was Lee Lindop with five fish.

Bill Rankin with two fish.

Four others with one fish each.

Second Tarsan comp on Sat 7 May 9 members weighed in at boathouse all had caught fish.

The top rod of the day was Paul McLean with 10 fish weighing 9lb 12ozs and he also had the heaviest fish of 11lb 6ozs.

In second place was Lee Lindop with 10 fish weighing 7lb 12ozs.

Bill Rankin was in third place with 10 fish weighing 7lbs 5ozs.

Fifty two fish were caught at a total weight of 38lbs.
